CPCWHS1001 – Prepare to work safely in the construction industry

Overview

The White Card course is a Nationally Recognised Training Course designed to provide participants with a basic understanding of Work, Health and Safety requirements and procedures used on general building, construction and civil sites. This course is mandatory for all persons working on construction sites in Australia. Note: *Currently White Cards issued in South Australia are nationally recognised and do not expire.*

1 day/8 hours (Face to Face)

Theory Assessment
Practical Assessment

Entry Requirements

Participants **MUST**:

- Be at least 16 years of age
- Be an Australian/New Zealand Citizen or hold an eligible VISA
- Have the required LLN skills to be able to do the following:
 - Understand English well enough to be able to read, write and provide verbal responses to questions in English independently
 - Numeracy skills to locate and recognise numbers commonly used on safety signs

Please note: ATEC only carries out assessments in English– Translators or Interpreters cannot be used.

Course Fees

The White Card course must be paid for on booking unless alternative arrangements have been made. Training will not be confirmed until payment has been received

Content

- Identify health and safety legislative requirements of construction work

- Identify construction hazards and risk control measures
- Identify health and safety communication and reporting processes.
- Identify incident and emergency response procedures.

Learner Requirements

- Provision of Australian legal photo identification for enrolment purposes.

PPE (Personal Protective Equipment)

To be supplied by participant:

- Closed in shoes
- Long pants; and a
- Long-sleeved shirt (for WHS reasons please do not wear excessively loose clothing)

On successful completion of all requirements of this course, learners will be issued with:

- 1) A Statement of Attainment for CPCWHS1001 – Prepare to work safely in the construction industry
- 2) Wallet Card **NB**: this card will be issued within 14 days of training along with your Statement of Attainment.
